

CABLE INSTALLATION

Park Avenue Homeowners Association permits installation of cable TV, Internet, and phone wires access subject to the following conditions for installation:

1. The Association assumes no responsibility for the maintenance, repairs, removal, or fees/charges of cable TV, Internet and phone access or any services associated with providing mentioned services. Damages to the structure of the premises during installation, repair or removal will be the Homeowner's responsibility.
2. The Association requires any coaxial cable(s) installation to comply with local Electrical Codes and FCC regulations. At the discretion of the installer and the Homeowner, the grounding cable may be routed under the driveway directly to the grounding rod or enter the cable through the garage attaching to the main meter box as required prior to attaching the cable to the grounding rod.
3. The Association requires the Homeowner to receive a Job Number from the installer to have the coaxial cable buried within a reasonable time.
4. The Association does not allow for cutting the driveway or sidewalk for installation of the cable. No access holes will be allowed in the vinyl siding or aluminum trim. Cables must not be visible against the vinyl siding, aluminum trim or on the roof.
5. The Homeowner is responsible to provide this form to their installer and see that the cable(s) are installed and buried per the Association's stated guidelines. Any deviations may require the installation to be redone and repair as needed at the Homeowner's or installer's expense.
